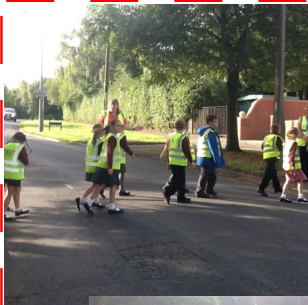


Our Year 3/4 children have been taking part in a Stepping Out programme led by a Road Safety Education Officer and supported by school staff this week. This is

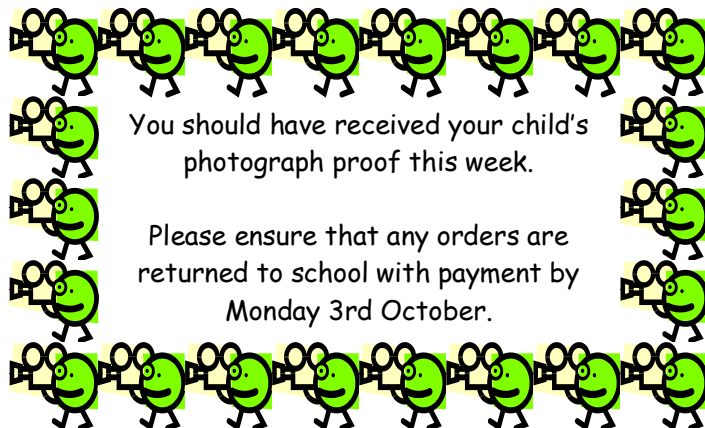
Forms need to be collected from Little Stars.
