School will be closed next Thursday 3rd May for all children EXCEPT YEAR 6!

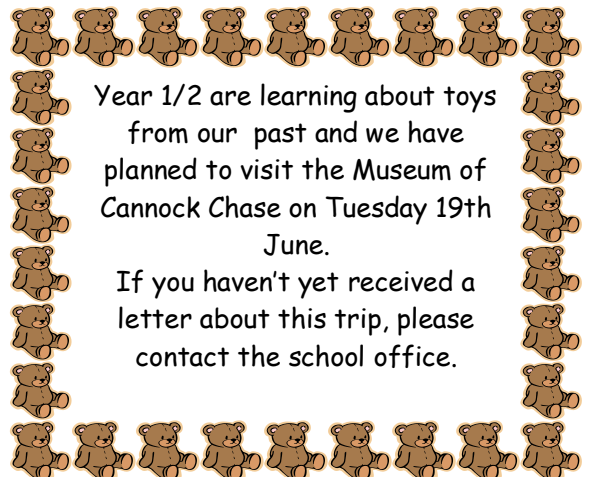
Year 6 are expected to come in from 8.35am until 1.15pm for a 'Booster Day' in preparation for their SATs.
