Our Autumn Term Parents evenings are on 14th and 15th November. We will be using the online booking system (Teachers2Parents) for you to make your appointment.

You will receive a text message from us which will give you a link to book your appointment. If you do not have access to the internet via your mobile phone you can type the link into the web browser on your computer/tablet.

If you have more than one child at the school you will be able to book all appointments at the same time, using the same link.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU LEAVE AT LEAST A 10 MINUTE GAP BETWEEN APPOINTMENTS FOR DIFFERENT CHILDREN. PLEASE DO NOT MAKE APPOINTMENTS STRAIGHT AFTER EACH OTHER. This will allow you time to move across school to different classrooms and to look at your child's books before your appointment.

If you have any difficulties using the system or do not have internet access, please contact the school office who will be happy to help you. Only one slot can be booked per child and appointments will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
