If anyone is able to volunteer to come into school to listen to our children reading, please let the school office know. Thanks.

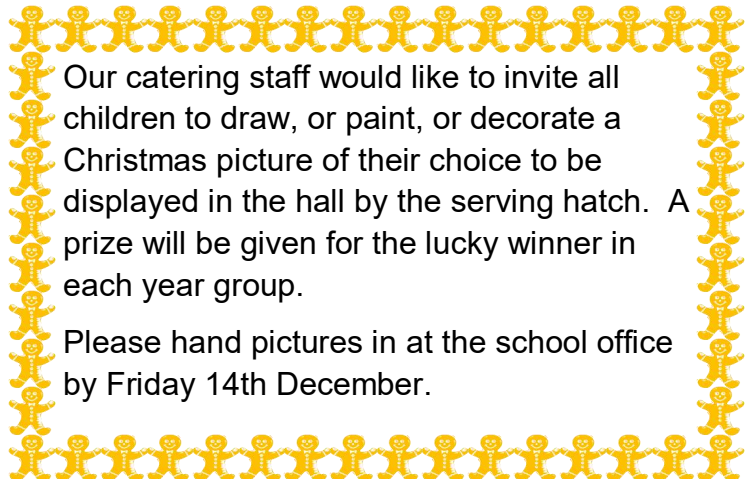


You should have received letters for:-
