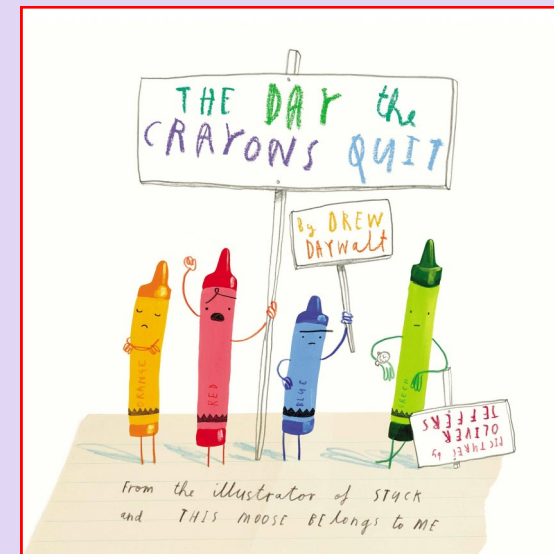

English

Y1- In Year 1, our main focus will be continuing to write basic sentences and use conjunctions. We will also learn how to use question marks and exclamation marks.

Y2- In Year 2, we will continue to consolidate our use of expanded noun phrases, similes and different sentence types.
