Safe, what a fabulous job we are all doing on this characteristic, all heroes doing our bit to Stay Safe, Protect the NHS and ourselves.

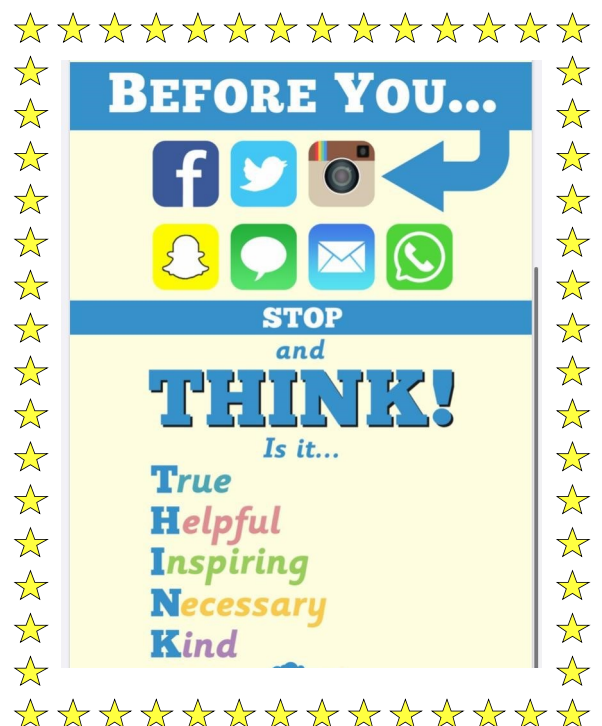
Keep Smiling, keep communicating, keep learning!

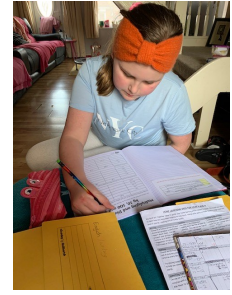
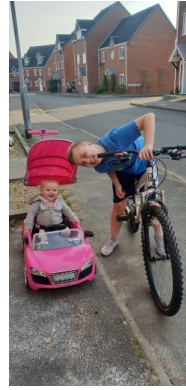

Jeremy Wade is a famous angler who does my favourite fishing programs like River Monsters and Dark Waters.


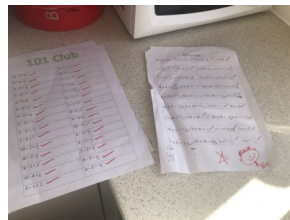
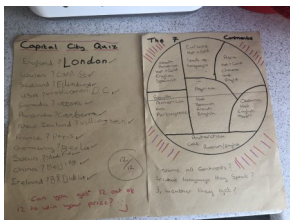
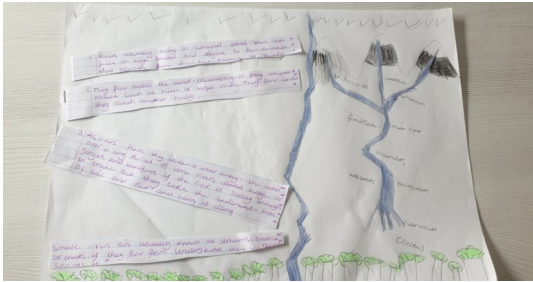
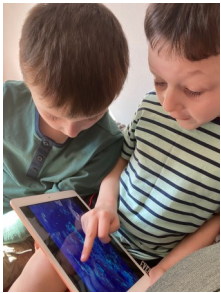
Born 23/05/1966 he was born in Ipswich. He has a degree in Zoology and a teaching certificate in Biological Sciences.
