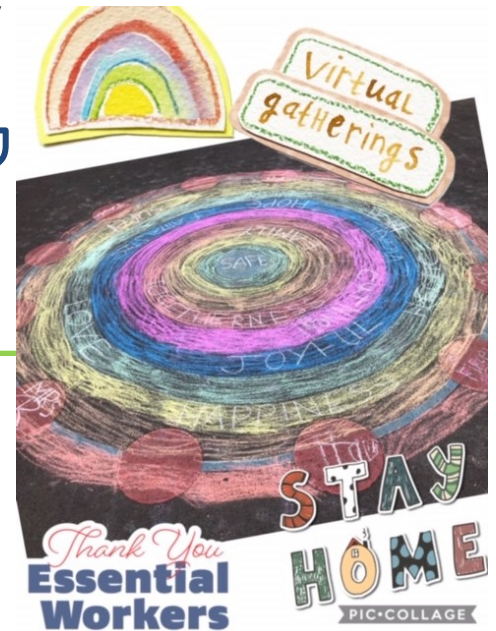
Stay Home, Stay Safe.

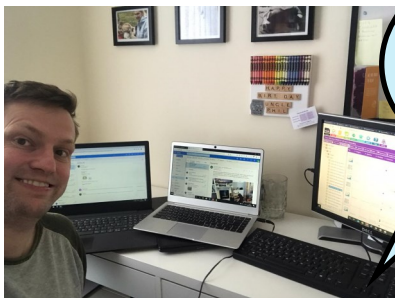
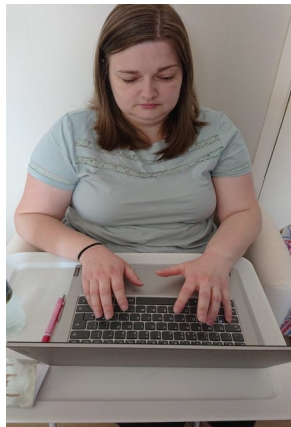
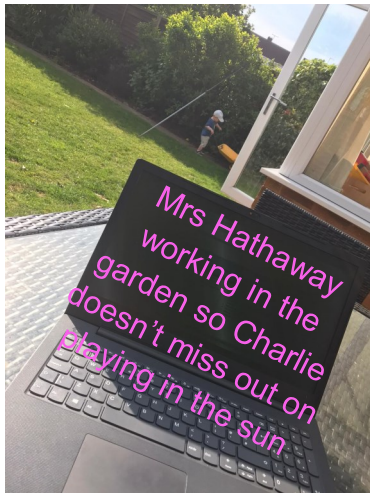
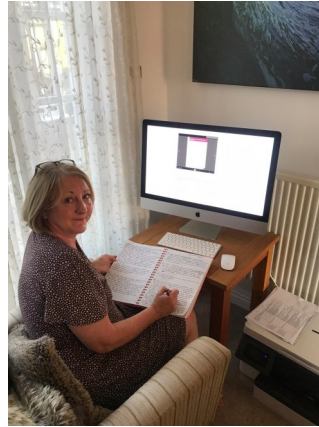
Our Home learning!

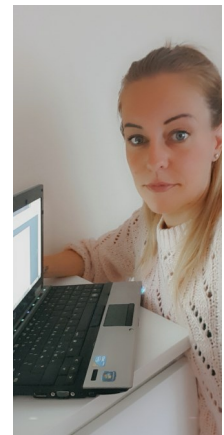
