Hi everyone

Thank you for your continued support during this strange and difficult time. The number of Key worker and vulnerable children in school has continued to increase as some parents start going back to work. If you are currently furloughed but will be returning to work before the summer holiday, please let us know as soon as possible if you need children in school, as we are very limited in how many spaces we now have for more children in school.

We will be opening for Year 6 and Year 1 children on Monday for their 3 day offer. We are only expecting the children who you have let us know will be returning - you cannot just arrive as we have to completed risk assessments for the number we are expecting.

With this in mind, I have to inform you that we will be unable to open further for any year groups, including Reception, for the remainder of the term. It is such a shame that we won't be able to see you all but we do not have the space or the adults to operate as needed to protect everyone and minimise the risks.

We will continue to provide home learning activities and Purple Mash activities for all year groups until the summer holidays. We will also be sending out End of Year Reports and information about next year classes etc by email - please let us know if you do not receive emails from us. 

General Information

- School remains closed to pupils except for those with Key Worker parents or those classed as vulnerable, Year 6 and Year 1.
- * We will not be able to reopen to Reception children as we do not have enough space available or adequate numbers of staff.
- NO ONE should enter the school building except for staff and children
- NO visitors or parents are allowed on the school site
- All children should be dropped off and collected from the Single gate on Bird's Bush road.
 The car park gates and back gate are not being used
- Children can only be dropped off and collected at their allocated time slot
- Social distancing must be observed at all times
- * Children should not bring anything into school except for a packed lunch (unless having school lunch) which must be in a paper or plastic bag to be thrown away.
- Children must wear fresh clothes daily, uniform is not necessary

We will continue to provide home learning packs for all year groups, including those eligible to return should you decide to keep them at home.

You will not be penalised for keeping children off school during the continued lockdown. The health and well being of your children and family is the most important thing. We will catch up on the learning elements.
