Hi everyone

It's been a military style operation in school this week as we welcomed back some of year 6 and year 1 and more Key worker children. Some days we are having around 50 children in school and we are all working hard to stick to the rules and stay in our 'bubble groups'.

We are now nearly full in all of the bubbles. If you think you may be returning to work before we break up for the summer holidays (July 20th) please let us know as soon as you can so that we can plan ahead. When we reach capacity we will not be able to accept any more children and we do not want this to affect you being able to go back to work.

School will close for the summer holidays from 20th July as planned. This is for all children including Key Worker and vulnerable groups. We are still waiting on further guidance from the government about any plans for provision during the summer holidays but this will not be provided by school.

One pleasing (and surprising) announcement by the government this week is that Free School Meals vouchers will continue to be paid out over the summer holidays. This means that if you are eligible for benefits driven FSM you will get £15 per child per week in one go - that's £90 if you have one child to spend in the supermarket! If your circumstances have changed and you think you may be eligible, please contact school and we can check for you.

Please keep on with the Home Learning and Purple Mash - I understand that it is becoming more difficult for some to be motivated with learning but try to keep some sort of routine and learning element in the day if possible.
