

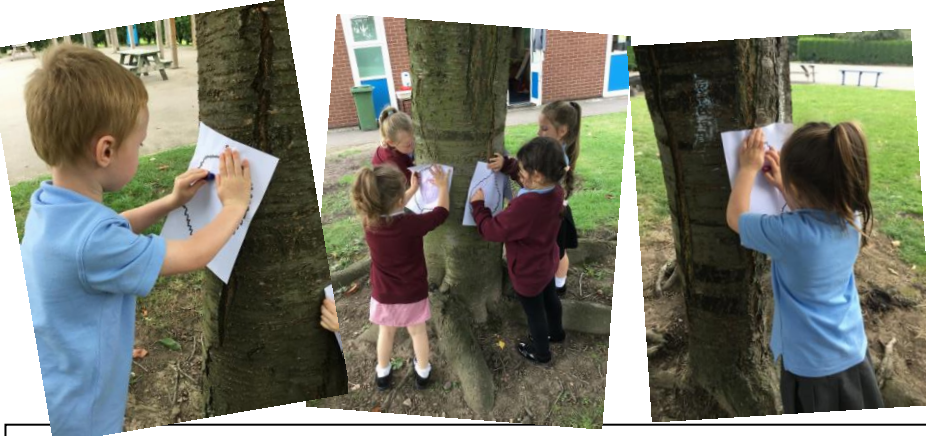


What have we been learning in Early Years this week?

The children have been doing very well in learning the picture mnemonic for each sound. We will be continuing to revisit these next week. However we will also be starting to introduce the first four sounds once the children are confident -

m a s d
