Mathematics

In Maths this week we have been learning how to sort objects into groups. The children found this tricky earlier in the week so instead of focusing on numbers 1, 2 and 3 we have been playing lots of sorting games. We have been sorting objects by colour and height. We have also been counting how many we have in each group. You could always try sorting things at home too.





The children love playing on the bikes outside. We are trying hard to negotiate space and not bump into our friends! We have also been encouraging the children to use full sentences when they would like a turn on the bike, rather than just asking an adult to help them, for example they have said 'Can I have a turn on the bike please?' to their friends.
