### Water bottles in school

Please make sure children only have PLASTIC water bottles in school. We have seen an increase in bottles which are the 'flask' type which have a glass inside - these are not suitable for school.

We have a supply of bottles of water in school if children do not bring them in or forget theirs.

We prefer that children only have WATER in their bottles. A number of children have split bottles already this term which have had squash in and this has ruined their work. Clear flavoured water is fine but please avoid coloured squash as it makes a mess when spilt.

Cans, glass bottles and fizzy drinks (including fizzy water) is not allowed.

### Snacks

A big thank you to parents who have supported our move to healthy snacks. Children in Reception and Key Stage 1 have free fruit available everyday.

Juniors can bring in a small snack for morning break if you want; fruit or a low sugar cereal bar is ideal. NO crisps or chocolate is allowed at break time.
