

October is Black History Month



October is Black History Month in the UK, an event that has been celebrated nationwide for more than 30 years. The month was originally founded to recognise the contributions that people of African and Caribbean backgrounds have made to the UK over many generations.

Now, Black History Month has expanded to include the history of not just African and Caribbean people but black people in general.

In school the children will be learning about significant Black people who have shaped the world in the past and present times. People such as Marcus Rashford, Mary Seacole, Shirley Bassey, Harold Moody, Michelle and Barack Obama and Will.I.Am.

The Prime Minister, Boris Johnson says it's important to celebrate the influence black people have had shaping Britain's history:

"For countless generations people of African and Caribbean descent have been shaping our nation's story, making a huge difference to our national and cultural life and helping to make Britain a better place to be.

"It is this contribution of black British people that I am proud to be celebrating Black History Month this October," he said.
