Over half term we will keep a close eye on the news for any changes to the guidance. Cases of the virus in Tamworth have been rising over the past few weeks so further restrictions may be enforced. We will keep you updated.

If any one in your household has a positive test result or if you are contacted by Test and Trace to self isolate over the holiday, please let us know by email to s.office@perryhallmat.co.uk - this will help us to have a picture of how many cases may affect us in school and enable us to prepare home learning if necessary.

Home learning packs will be available for any child who needs to isolate. Packs can be sent by email or can be collected from the front of school (by arrangement with the office). The BBC Bitesize website and The Oak Academy have home learning videos and activities for children available all of the time.

HALF TERM FREE SCHOOL MEALS VOUCHERS

COVID-19 has changed the way we live, work and learn. We know that family life is harder at the moment with families facing increased pressure on household budgets, so Staffordshire County Council is seeking to support families through a COVID-19 October Half-Term Free School Meals Fund. This will enable eligible children (and their families) to be supported during the school break with access to supermarket eVouchers purchased by the Local Authority. This Fund is operated by Staffordshire County Council and does not form part of a national scheme.

All details for those who completed the application for have been submitted to Staffordshire County Council. eVouchers will be provided directly to you by 5:00pm on Monday 26th October 2020 at the latest. If you have not received their eVoucher by this point, then you should contact the local Family Hub.

Once families have received the eVoucher, you will be able to redeem them in store at the selected retailer by either:

- Presenting the eVoucher on a smartphone or tablet
- Presenting a paper copy of the eVoucher

Should you have any issues redeeming the eVoucher you are asked to contact the appropriate District Family Hub.














Autumn Term Parent Consultation Meetings
