The children have loved using their playdough this week. They have their own individual tubs with their names on. We have been carefully manipulating the playdough to make candles for our cakes. This has been helping the children to build up the strength in their hands and fingers. We have also been counting the candles.

Read Write Inc.

This week we have learned the sounds:

m, a, s, d

The children are doing very well but have found 'd' a little bit tricky as it has a similar shape to 'a'.

You could help your child by practising this sound at the weekend. You could paint it, draw it, hide it, chalk it on the pavement etc. It will also help the children to find things around the house beginning with 'd' such as 'd, d door' or 'd, d, drink'

Mathematics

In Maths this week we have been learning all about the numbers one, two and three. We use Numberblocks to help us learn in school. We have been putting these numbers in order, talking about which numbers are bigger/smaller and we have even been looking at one more! The children have done a great job and we look forward to learning more numbers next week!



This week we went on an Autumn walk around school. We talked about how the world around us changes in Autumn and we went out to spot leaves changing, berries on the ground, we even saw a squirrel climbing a tree! We collected lots of lovely leaves and sticks which we have been sorting outside and we have also used them inside on our light panel in the classroom.
