English

We will be looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction texts to build our reading skills and writing skills, including writing instructions, non-chronological reports and writing a diary entry.

Texts: *The Pebble in My Pocket*

Volcanos & Earthquakes

Art/DT

We will be exploring pneumatic systems that use air to work to make a working volcano.

Geography
