

We are so pleased that the children can come back to school on 8th March - we are looking forward to seeing them all in person again and getting on with real interactive teaching and learning. You have all been amazing but it's not the same as all of the children being in the classroom together.

We understand that some of you may still have anxieties about your children returning to school, and we cannot guarantee that there won't be any cases in school, but we will continue to try our best to minimise the risk of transmission and hope that our whole community will follow all of the guidance to help keep everyone safe.

Staff are all doing twice weekly Lateral Flow tests before coming into school and some staff have been in priority groups for the vaccine, we are hoping that everyone who wants it, will be able to have it soon.

We are changing some of the arrangements for the day in school to maximise learning time - please check what time your child's start and end time is. Social distancing is essential but we cannot make people keep their distance, it is everyone's responsibility to do their bit by being on time for your slot (not early or late) and by keeping a safe distance from other people on the paths and pavements around school.

One important job this weekend is to dig out **school uniform** and check it still fits! Especially **Shoes**!

We have some pre-loved school uniform available on our sale rack - please email the office if you need any uniform and we will check if we have what you need.

Parent Consultation Evenings - Due to the disrupted nature of this term, the Trust have decided that we will move the Spring term consultation evening for parents to the first week back after Easter, these will be via Teams like last time. Waiting a few extra weeks will enable us to settle the children back into school, complete assessments and set clear individual targets for progress for the summer term. We will send out more information for booking before Easter.














4 - Thursday 4th March
