
Tell them, "WE will recover - TOGETHER!"










































2 - Changes to planned training days.

3 - Operation Encompass

The school has been given the opportunity to take part in a project that will run jointly between schools and Staffordshire Police.

Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced, any domestic abuse.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the school staff, (Designated Safeguarding Lead) known as a Key Adult, is trained to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared, in confidence, while ensuring that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been experienced a domestic abuse incident.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.

In our school we have a number of staff trained to a higher level in Safeguarding. Mrs Barnes is the Designated Safeguarding Lead with Mrs Davies, Mr Mahay, Mrs Hall, Miss Thornton and Denese also trained as Deputy Safeguarding leads. If you have any concerns about a child you can discuss your worries with us.

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility and in school we have a statutory duty to report any concerns we have to children's social care - sometimes we have to do this without talking to parents first. We understand that this can be distressing for families, especially when children tell us things without any context around the situation. Please remember that we always have safety and welfare of our children at the heart of all decisions that we take.
