It has been a very busy week! The children (and staff!) are exhausted and looking forward to a long weekend. Lots of lovely learning is happening all over school and on Tuesday we had a visit from the Executive Team from Perry Hall Multi Academy Trust to carry out a Teaching and Learning review across school. Due to Covid it is over a year since the team has been into Bird's Bush and they were really excited to see how we are doing.

The verbal feedback from the review was really positive and we were delighted that our improvements and hard work clearly shines through in all areas - especially from the children. They were amazing; they couldn't wait to tell the team about school and what a wonderful place it is to learn and how adults help them if they are worried or 'stuck'.

Due to Covid, the formal inspection of schools by OfSTED has been delayed, this means that we may not be inspected until the Autumn term despite being due by July this year. This will be our first inspection since joining the Academy Trust and we actually want them to visit to see the changes that have taken place and give us the recognition we deserve.



2 - Year 4 Receive letters from the House of Commons

Before Easter Y4 were learning about changes to the environment and the impact of people on the natural environment. During one lesson they became quite concerned about the plans for HS2 and the impact locally and decided they wanted to make a protest! In English they had been learning

about balanced arguments and debate so they decided to write a letter to our local MP, Christopher Pincher, to raise their concerns - particularly about how close it is to Kingsbury Water Park.

Today, every child in Year 4 received a reply from Mr Pincher responding to their concerns. In his letter he states "All of you in Year 4 have shown to me not only your concern about HS2 in a very structured and eloquent manner and I am very impressed......Thank you for writing to me....we must all as a community use our voice to make sure it does as little damage and brings as much good as possible. I am very pleased you have used yours."

Well done Year 4.




Friday 7th May is National Number Day! Be a ROCK STAR!


