

## PE

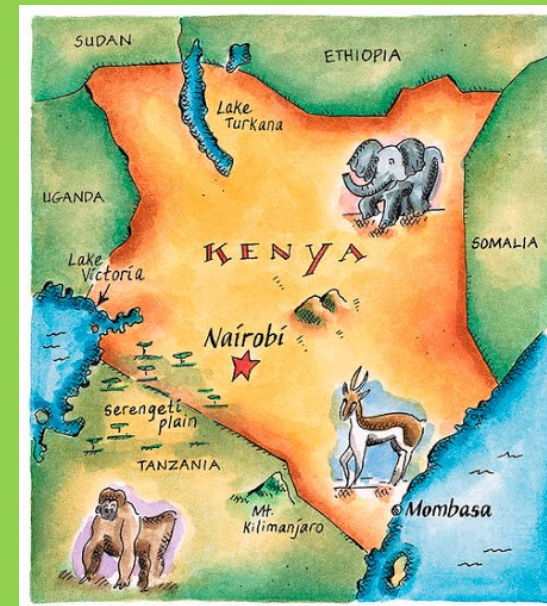
