## Curriculum Passport Year 3 Summer 1 - 2021 How different is Brazil?



## English

We will be focussing on narrative writing based on the story—Charlie Small—Gorilla City, following Charlie Small as he explores a new land. We will be writing a diary entry, character description and our own story. For this, we will be developing writing skills, such as, correctly using the past tense, subordinating conjunctions, using paragraphs, powerful adjectives and adverbs and more!

## Art/DT

As part of our theme on Brazil, we will be making a 3d rainforest in a box in pairs. We will be developing our cutting techniques, making slots in the cardboard and using flaps for effect to create our work.

## Geography

We will be developing our location knowledge by comparing The UK with Brazil, primarily looking at the human and physical features of Brazil and our country. This will involve looking at the people and places, like the Amazon and the climate there.

## Maths
