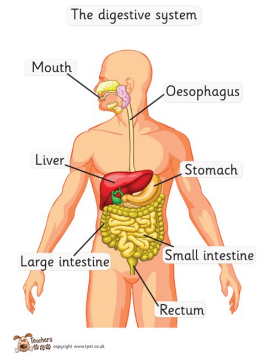

Where does all that food go? We will be recapping our learning about food groups and then learning about the digestive system! What really happens to all of the food that we eat? We will also be learning about teeth.



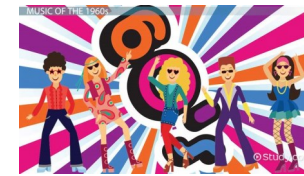
DT
