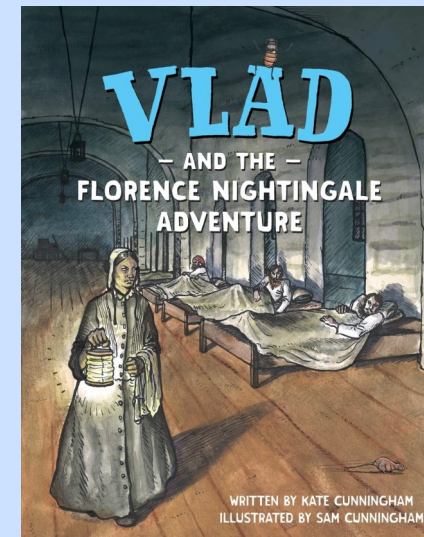

English

In writing this term, we will be focusing on writing a variety of different sentence types, using adjectives to describe and using conjunctions (and, because) in our writing.

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and measurement (capacity, length and height)

Science

In Science, our topic this is 'Our Senses'. We will be using our different senses to answer scientific questions and take part in investigations. We will also be using our sight to observe seasonal changes.

Your child has access to a variety of library books. These can be changed every morning.
