




Currículum Passport Year 4 Summer 2 2021

English

We will be focussing on non fiction writing this half term, including instructions, a nonchronological report and an explanation text.





Maths

Year 4 will take part in the Multiplication Tables Check this half term.

We will be learning about: Decimals Measures Fractions Recap of the four operations

Science

We will be learning all about electricity and which items use electricity. We will then be creating simple circuits with



lightbulbs, switches and buzzers and working out how to fix a circuit that doesn't work. We'll also investigate which other materials could be used instead of wires.

Art/DT
