

Primary Science Quality Mark



The Primary Science Quality Mark is awarded to infant, junior, primary, middle and special schools to celebrate their commitment to excellence in science teaching and learning. So far, since its national launch in 2010, over 4000 schools across the UK have achieved a prestigious Primary Science Quality Mark.


The Primary School Quality Mark programme ensures effective leadership of science, enables schools to work together to share good practice and is supported by professional development led by local experts. It encourages teacher autonomy and innovation while at the same time offering a clear framework for development in science subject leadership, teaching and learning. Schools that achieve PSQM demonstrate commitment and expertise in science leadership, teaching and learning.

Mrs Gould (Science leader) said "In working towards the Primary Science Quality Mark, the profile of science has improved, children will stop and chat about what they have been learning and they are proud of their science. It is as important as English and Maths and we try to link our learning so that children can remember things more. Children have never been more enthusiastic about Science and they love taking part in more investigations. Children are happy to ask questions and share their ideas with their friends.

Mr Barnes, Headteacher, said "Children still talk about Science week from last year and how much fun they had with their learning. We also learn about famous scientists and the influence that they have had on our world. At Bird's Bush we love science and we are delighted that we have been awarded the quality mark again."

























- headache
- a loss of taste or smell
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- tiredness
