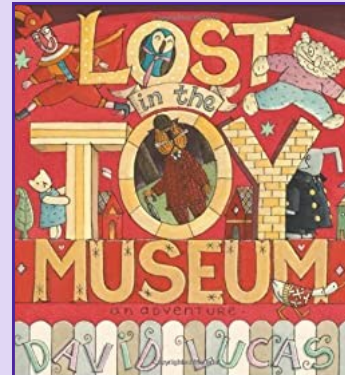

English

In writing, we are continuing to develop our use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We are also learning how to use adjectives and conjunctions such as 'and' and 'because' in our writing. We will also be developing our retrieval, inference and sequencing skills in reading.

DT

In DT, we are making our own peg dolls. We will be learning how to tie dye as well as how to cut and join materials as part of the process.

Gymnastics

History

In History, we are exploring the changes that have occurred with toys over time and we are going to learn about the creation of the teddy bear.

Maths

Science

In Science, we are learning about our senses and using them to investigate different smells, tastes, sights, sounds and how different materials feel to touch.
