


Year 3 Egyptian Day




World Book Day will be a whole day dedicated to our love of reading. There will be whole school activities, such as creating our own Storytatoes! Resources for this will be provided in school but any donations of craft items, such as googly eyes, pipe cleaners, coloured card, pompoms etc would be gratefully received.



The children's Storytatoes will be sent home with them. All children will be set a Purple Mash homework to create The Potato Chronicles. Children will be challenged to take their potato on an adventure and then write a story about it. Where has their potato been? What has it seen? Pictures of the children's potatoes in various locations/situations to go alongside their stories would be fantastic! Their contributions will be displayed at school so they can be shared with the rest of the school. Please do not feel that you need to go anywhere special for this. The story could be set in your home!

We have also challenged the staff to be creative with making a Super-Story-tato of their own for the children to judge!
