We hope you have had a lovely Easter break, this half term is really short and we are making the most of every day of learning. The current guidance in place is now that Covid is considered the same as any other cough or cold - there is no separate register code for Covid related absences so it does now count in your child's attendance figures. There is no longer a directed requirement to test if you have symptoms and isolate if that test is positive, the information currently is that you are advised to isolate for 5 day or 3 days for under 16s. The isolation period is to help prevent spread.

Our Trust have set out guidelines for staff that does require us to isolate for 5 days if we have symptoms then a positive test result to minimise the risk to others in our schools.

Please help us to minimise the risk of any illness spreading in school.



Breaktime Snacks

A quick reminder that children should only bring healthy snacks in for breaktime NO chocolate, sweets or crisps - these are okay to go with a packed lunch in small amounts.

Fruit is the healthiest option and all children in Reception and Key Stage 1 are given free fruit in school.

Other suggestions:

• Cereal bar (low sugar, no chocolate)

- Vegetable sticks
- Tube type yoghurt
- Hard-boiled egg
- Smoothie

If children bring chocolate, sweets or crisps into school for breaktime they will not be allowed to eat them until lunchtime and we will give them some fruit instead.






Year 6 have their SATs week from 9th May - please make sure they are getting lots of sleep and time for revision.




