How Does Your Garden Grow?

English

In writing this term, we are continuing to develop our use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops whilst also learning how to use 'and' and 'because' in our writing. We will also be learning how to write questions and how to use exclamation marks to show expression.

<u>Art</u>

In Art, our focus is painting. We will be learning about primary and secondary colours and completing an artist study of Georgia O'Keefe.

PE & Games

This term, our focus will be outdoor games using dodging skills, footwork and throwing/ catching skills. Please note that outdoor PE will be on a Tuesday afternoon.

Geography

In Geography, we will be focusing on human and physical features of the UK, starting with our school and the local area before looking further afield.

RE and PSHE

<u>Science</u>

In Science, we are learning about how our gardens grow. We will be investigating the types of flowers we can see around our school, the jobs of the different parts of a plant and the differences between trees and plants. We will be observing plants closely and then sketching what we can see.

This term, we will be using the IPADs to take pictures and zoom in to observe details.
