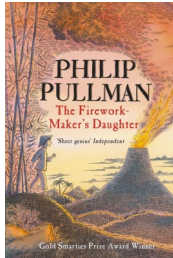

History

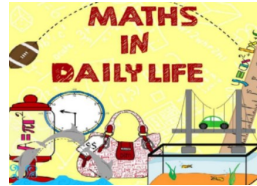
We will be learning about life in Ancient China during the Shang Dynasty. We will develop our understanding of chronology and the characteristic features of the past, such as beliefs and customs.
