
One of our children asked Mr Pincher why the black bins on his street had not been emptied for 2 weeks - he asked for the address and assured him that he would look into it.




Y6 definitely do Rock!!!! They beat the rest of the school in the TTRS battle set by Mrs Hathaway!!!! Well done Y6.
