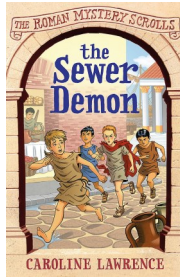

## English

We will be focussing on both fiction and non fiction this half term. We will be writing instructions, an explanation text and our own ending to a Roman story.

We will enjoy reading the Sewer Demon, developing our inference, retrieval and vocabulary skills.



## Maths

Year 4 will take part in the Multiplication Tables Check this half term.

We will be learning about:  
Decimals  
Measures  
Fractions  
Recap of the four operations  
Shape = angles.

## Science

We will be learning all about our bodies, digestion and how our teeth help with this process. We will be looking at human teeth and other animal teeth and the importance of looking after them. We will learn how food is broken up and the journey it takes.
