change donations. In addition, on that day, our school are going to be visited by some special RTTW guests on their motorbikes!

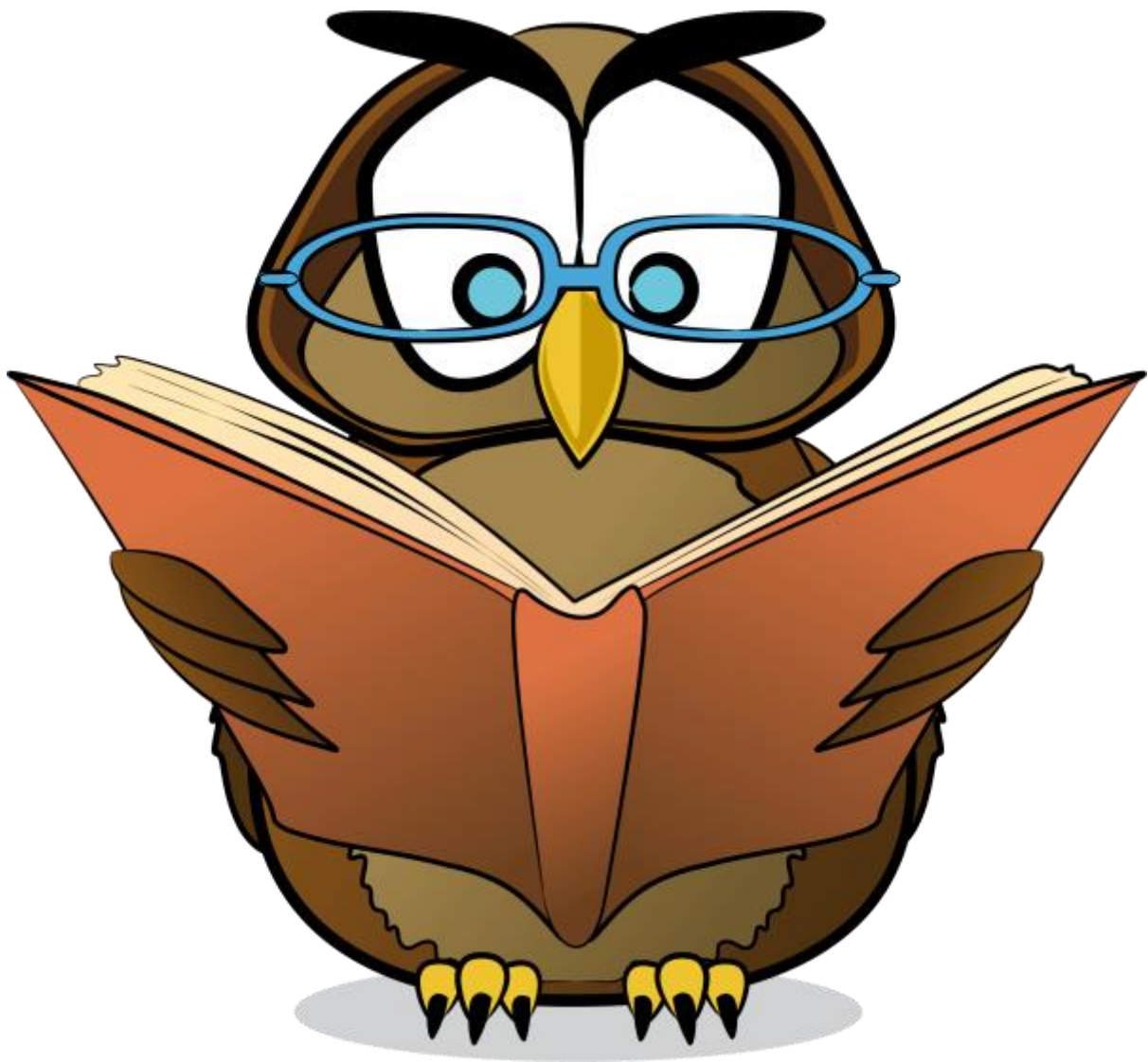

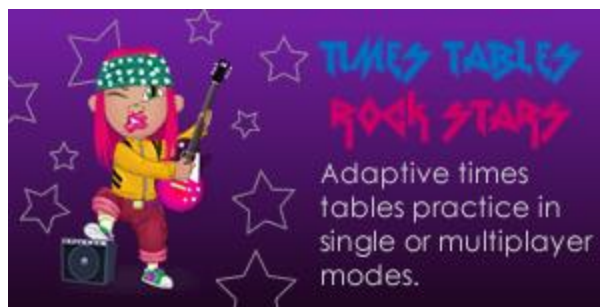

A new lunch time club will be starting in the next couple of weeks called The Great Outdoors. At this club, children will have the opportunity to:

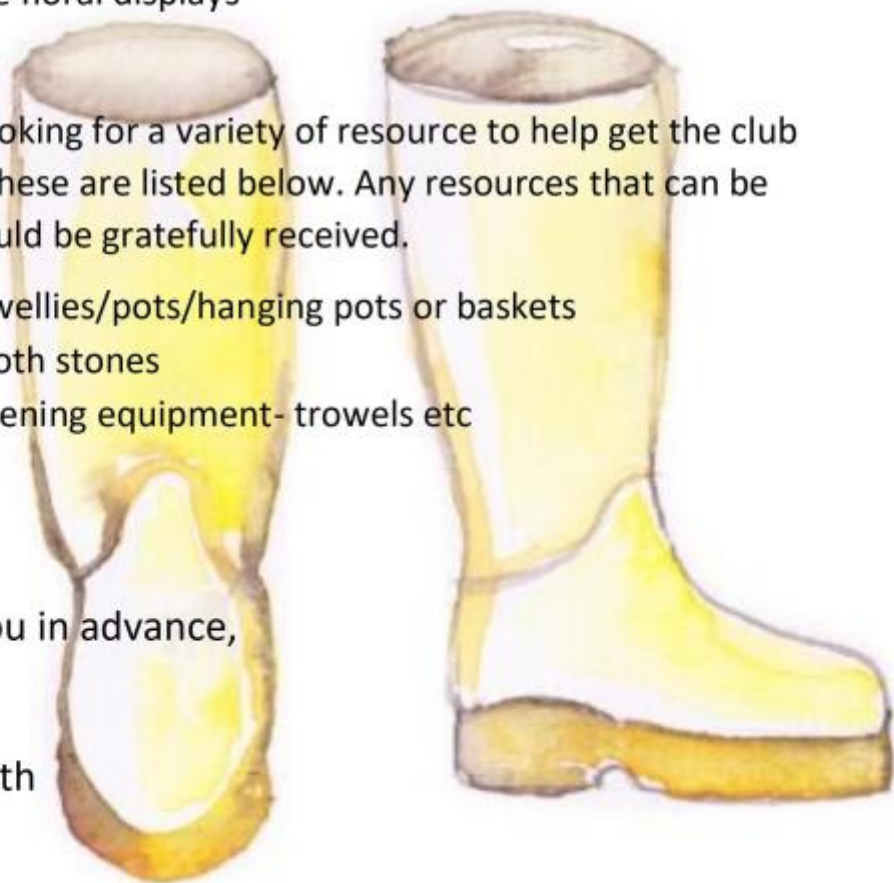
- Be outside in the fresh air
