English

In writing, we are continuing to use Talk for Writing to develop the children as story tellers. Which will support the use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in all of our writing. We are also continuing learning how to use adjectives and conjunctions such as 'and' and 'because' in our writing. This term the children will start using exclamation marks in their writing.

ART

In Art will continue the theme of colour creating our final piece. Then we will move on to style, exploring different art movements such as pointillism, realism and abstract.

Geography

In Geography, we are exploring the United Kingdom and the counties in holds. Continuing to explore the human and physical features of each country.

Maths

In maths, we are continuing to develop our understanding of number and place value working up to and across 100, recognising the numeral and word for each number. We will be counting in 2s,5s,10s. Using these skills to solve addition and subtraction problems with missing numbers $7 - _ = 3$. Exploring the measurements of time, money and capacity.
In arithmetic this term we will be solving, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems.

RE and PSHE

RE

We are learning beliefs and the stories in the Bible that promote the beliefs in the Christian faith.

PSHE

We are learning to understand our relationships and valuing ourselves.

Science

In Science, we exploring how plants grow. Looking at where and what plants need to grow. We will be planting various plants and crops to explore this with a real hands on approach. Finishing with a trip to Manor Fruits Farm.

Music

We will be exploring sounds and performance within the topics Storytime and travel.

Computing

The children are going to be using the computers and iPads to develop their coding skills and understanding how programs are built.
