
PE

How to support your child at home: Homework tasks are set each Friday using Purple Mash, alternatively paper based homework may also be given out. Please complete these by the following Thursday in exchange for a homework ticket. TTRockstars is available for the children to play online.

Reading is incredibly important and we ask that you hear your child read at least 3 times a week. Please sign their reading diary after each read and we will exchange these for Read It tickets. The children will either bring home a book banded book or a RWI book to read, both are closely matched to their reading/phonic ability. The RWI books will be changed every Thursday. Book banded books may be changed as frequently as required, although we would urge you to read these more than once to help support your child's fluency.

Library books are available within the classroom. These are chosen to be read to or with your child. The children may change these every Tuesday.
